

Player Code of Conduct

- 1. My conduct on the sideline must always glorify our Lord, Jesus Christ.
- 2. Respect for coaches, teammates, opponents, and officials is expected at all times.
- 3. Use of drugs, alcohol, and tobacco is prohibited while representing the team.
- 4. Any form of bullying or harassment will not be tolerated.
- 5. Attendance at all practices and games is mandatory, unless excused by the coach.
- 6. All equipment must be properly cared for and returned in a timely manner.
- 7. Any violation of team rules may result in disciplinary action, up to and including dismissal from the team.
- 8. Players are expected to maintain good academic standing and to represent the team with pride and integrity.
- 9. Players must conduct themselves in a manner that brings credit to the team, and community.
- 10. Any actions that would compromise the integrity of the game will not be tolerated.
- 11. All players must follow the rules and regulations set forth by the association, conference, and governing bodies of the sport.
- 12. Players must show respect for the game by participating to the best of their ability, playing fairly, and avoiding unsportsmanlike conduct.
- 13. Players must always act with the safety of themselves and others in mind, and must follow all safety guidelines provided by coaches and medical staff.
- 14. Players must always adhere to the rules and regulations of the association and the governing bodies of the sport, and must avoid any actions that could result in penalties for the team or individual players.
- 15. Players must maintain a high level of physical and mental conditioning, and must be willing to work hard to improve their skills.
- 16. Players must take responsibility for their own actions, and must be willing to accept consequences for any violations of team rules or policies.
- 17. Players must show respect for the opposing team and their fans, and must avoid any actions that could incite violence or provoke negative reactions.

- 18. Players must maintain a positive attitude and be supportive of their teammates at all times.
- 19. Players must be willing to put the team's needs above their own, and must always be willing to sacrifice personal goals for the good of the team.
- 20. Players must maintain a high level of discipline, and must avoid any actions that could lead to penalties, disqualifications or ejections.
- 21. Players must maintain a professional attitude and behavior both on and off the field and represent the team and the association with pride and integrity.
- 22. Players must be aware that their actions on social media can reflect on themselves, their teammates, and the team as a whole, and must therefore be mindful of the content they post online.
- 23. Players must avoid posting any offensive, derogatory, or inappropriate content on social media, and must not engage in any behavior that could be considered bullying, harassment, or discrimination.
- 24. Players must not post any confidential or sensitive information about the team or its members on social media, and must respect the privacy of their teammates.
- 25. Players must not post any information or comments that could be considered a violation of team rules or policies, or that could damage the team's reputation.
- 26. Players must not post any information or comments that could be considered a violation of association rules or policies, or that could damage the association's reputation.
- 27. Players must be aware that their social media accounts may be monitored by coaches, association officials, and other team representatives, and must be prepared to take responsibility for their actions online.
- 28. Players should not post any information about games, training, or other team-related activities without prior approval from the coach or other team representatives.
- 29. Players should use social media to promote teamwork, sportsmanship, and positive representation of the team and association.
- 30. Players must be careful not to disclose any sensitive information related to the game strategy, or any personal information about the team members on social media.
- 31. Players must refrain from posting anything negative about the team, coaches, opponents or officials on social media, especially after the game.
